**SEM Committee Decision for the Regulatory Authorities in relation to Mod\_05\_14  
(Recommendation Report FRR\_05\_14 v.2.0)**

Dear Sherine,

On 6 March 2014, the Modifications Committee submitted its Modification Recommendation Report with regard to a Modification Proposal, Mod\_05\_14 (Update of AGU and DSU Registration Provisions), in accordance with paragraph 2.213 of the SEM Trading and Settlement Code (the Code).

This Modification Proposal, which was raised by the Regulatory Authorities (RAs), proposes to update the Code provisions with respect to the registration of Aggregated Generator Units (AGUs) and Demand Side Units (DSUs) to clarify the requirements for Parties seeking to register such Units and to enable the Regulatory Authorities to impose obligations on such Parties through mechanisms which are consistent with the differences in their statutory positions. The proposal also seeks to clarify and simplify the provisions in the Code regarding such registration.

The SEM Committee notes that these proposals cannot affect any Party that has already received RA consent for the registration of a DSU or of an AGU. The SEM Committee further notes that the Modifications Committee agreed unanimously that the Modification Proposal furthers the Code Objectives “to provide transparency in the operation of the Single Electricity Market” (through the simplification of the relevant Code provisions) and “to ensure no undue discrimination between persons who are parties to the Code” (through the assurance that all Generator Units are subject to the same relevant obligations under licenses of agreements). The Modifications Committee also recommended that the Modification Proposal should be implemented on a Trading Day basis, one Working Day after the Regulatory Authority decision is made.

Considering the above, and in accordance with paragraph 2.218 of the Code the SEM Committee directs that a Modification, as set out in Appendix 1 of FRR\_05\_14 v.2.0, be made on a Trading Day basis with effect from one Working Day after the date of this letter.
